



SENIOR MASTERS INVITATION SINGLES

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The competition shall be played on a league basis to establish the winner and runner-up.
2. The winner of each match shall be the player first scoring 21 shots. No shots in excess of 21 will be recorded.
3. One point shall be recorded for each match won and the winner shall be the player with the highest number of points.
4. In the event of equality of points, the winner shall be the player with the highest net score. Should equality still exist, the total shots each player has scored shall be divided by the total shots scored against the player; the higher resulting figure shall determine the winner. Should equality still exist, the winner of the original game played between those players shall be the winner.
5. In the event of a player withdrawing for any reason after the commencement of the tournament, the results of all matches in which such player played shall be expunged from the records.
6. In the event of adverse weather conditions or for any other acceptable reason, the Controlling Body shall have the right to curtail the number of rounds to be played and/or shots required to win a match in order to determine the winner and runner-up.
7. Registration will be at **08:00** on the first day and play will commence at **08:30** every day. There shall be FOUR sessions a day with a bye during one of the sessions. There shall be no set tea and lunch intervals but such will be taken when having a bye.
8. The Controlling Body shall have the right to change allocated rinks at any time.
9. In the interest of speeding up play, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head after the player's own third bowl has been delivered, unless permission has been requested and given by the marker.
10. Dress Code.

It is a requirement in terms of the dress code that players in this event wear their highest colours.
